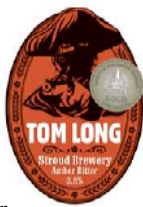


Blindman's Buff (3.6%) Amber coloured

Tom Long, 3.8% is an amber coloured bitter with a spicy citrus aroma. This beer won Overall Champion for the West of England and Wales, 2008 in the Society of Independent Brewers Awards.



Cheddar Ales - Totty Pot (4.5%) is a rich, dark porter with a deeply satisfying roasted malt character and subtle hop highlights. It is brewed using the best quality Maris Otter, wheat and dark malts and hopped with a blend of English whole hops.



Matthews Brewery in Timsbury - Brassknocker (3.8%) shortlisted for the Champion Beer of Britain competition in August 2007. A Golden Ale with a citrus aroma full of fresh lemons and spicy orange zest. The mouth is filled with vanilla malt and left with a long and satisfying bitter finish. An easy-drinking "session beer" with a character that you will find refreshing at any time of year.



Budding (4.5%) from the Stroud Brewery. This is a pale ale with Fuggles used as the main bittering hop - then late hopped for a luscious floral aroma. - Champion Beer of Gloucestershire 2006



TUNNEL I.P.A. - Trade Winds (4.6% abv) A heavenly aromatic, copper coloured beer. It has an aroma rich in cascade hops spilling over into clean crisp hints of citrus. Quickly followed by a rush of fruity malts that are pursued by an exquisitely dry finish, full of scented hops. A Pale Ale like it ought to be!



Nailsworth Brewery's Artist Ale (3.9%) - A hoppy, zingy, tangy thirst quenching bitter full of citrus flavours. A refreshingly more-ish session

Wye Valley's HPA (4.0%) - A delightful pale ale, smooth on the palate with a citrus hop aroma leading to a balanced bitter finish. Ingredients:- Pale malt and Wheat malt. English Target and Styrian Goldings hops.



Oakleaf Brewery from Gosport - Hole Hearted (4.7%) Brewed with 100% Cascade hops. This powerful, floral and fruity beer will surprise with every mouthful.



RCH Brewery RCH's Steam Harvest (4.8%) - a special brew of a paler bitter

Hidden Brewery's Hidden Pleasure (4.9%) - A deep golden coloured, strong, dry, traditional IPA with a big hoppy finish - delicious.



Cheddar—Gorge Best Bitter (4.0%) The intricate blend of hops in this distinguished Best Bitter provides a clean bitter taste that complements the warm malt flavours perfectly. It is brewed using the best quality Maris Otter and Crystal malts and hopped with a blend of English whole hops.



Exe Valley Brewery Dobs best (4.1%) - a very spe-



Zero Degrees Black Lager (4.8%) A deep dark Czech style lager, roasted and caramelised malts give chocolate and coffee flavours & a lasting cappuccino-style collar of foam.

Oakleaf's I Can't Believe It's Not Bitter (4.9%) ...cos it's not! A cask conditioned lager. Clean and crisp with a fruity aftertaste. The use of Saaz hops gives this lager a citrus finish that lingers on.



Heart of Wales Bitter (4.1%) A light chestnut bitter in the Northern style, it has a fine smooth balance between malt and hop. Eminently moreish it has the ability to satisfy your thirst whilst leaving you wanting more!



East Street Cream (5.0%) by RCH. A full bodied beer with a malty hoppy fruit bitter and a sweet taste. A complex and well-crafted premium chestnut-coloured ale.

Lady of the Lake (4.2%) by Glastonbury Ales. A full-bodied, amber best bitter.



Stonehenge Ales' Danish Dynamite (5.0%) - A light golden, dry, strong ale, slightly fruity with a well balanced hop flavour and bitterness



Mine Beer (4.2%) by Blindmans Brewery. A full-bodied copper coloured rich blended malt ale.

Box Steam Brewery - Tunnel Vision (4.2%). Well rounded traditional bitter beer. Clean tasting with a slight bitterness on the palate.



Zero Degrees Wheat Ale (4.2%) Often pale, traditionally cloudy, always refreshing and easy-drinking. Brewed in various styles - including the quenching American wheat ale, the vanilla and banana flavoured German hefe-weizen, or the orange and spicy Belgian witbier.



Potholer (4.3%) by Cheddar Ales. Brewed with a blend of Maris Otter, Crystal and Wheat malts and a combination of the choicest Challenger and Styrian Golding whole hops, this golden ale delivers zesty, fruity flavours with a smooth rounded finish and bags of aroma.



BEER FACTORY Bristol Beer Factory's Exhibition Ale (5.2%)

Otter Head (5.8%) by Otter has a distinctive barley wine old ale character. It has a malt, fruit sweet flavour which gives way to a long bittersweet aftertaste. It has a well balanced aroma that reflects its taste and is deep red brown in colour.



Moonshine (4.3%) by Abbeydale - a beautifully balanced pale straw-coloured premium bitter with a distinctive floral aroma, leading to a predominantly citrus taste, with grapefruit and lemons to the fore, and a quenching

Dorset Gold (4.5%) by Palmers. A truly golden premium ale, refreshing and thirst-quenching, full, fruity and lightly hopped with Kent goldings



Wickwar Brewery - Mr Perretts Traditional Stout 5.9%. A powerful stout with liquorice & chocolate bursting throughout, and a very long finish.

Wye Valley's Dorothy Goodbody Country Ale - 6.0% A strong ruby ale bursting with rich malt flavours and hop bitterness.



Downton brewery Chimera (6.8%) is bursting with resin and hoppy flavours. Chimera packs quite a punch, as a traditional IPA should.



Ciders



A sweet & a dry from Wilkins of Mudgley near Wedmore. Cheddar Valley from Thatchers Hecks Cider and Perry from Street



St Austell brewery - Proper Job (4.5%) An authentic IPA brewed with Cornish spring water and malt made from a blend of malts including Cornish grown Maris Otter barley. A powerfully hopped golden bitter that explodes with citrus grapefruit flavours.
